The first is to rent a car,

Several rental companies operate at Cape Town International Airport, including, Avis, Sixt, Europcar, Hertz and Woodford. Prices vary, but it's generally a cost-effective option way of getting around.

We rented a car from Woodford for a weekend last year and it cost only about 50 euro for the first 400km. (It was however off season). Of course, the more people that stick together and share the cost and driving duties the better! So keep in touch with one another and plan accordingly!

The second is Uber.

Uber is generally a safe way of getting around Cape Town and it works in the Franschoek area as well.
